This September Education we will focus on Safe Resident Handling Training, and, we have our ongoing implementation of safety huddles on our units. At present 4 out of the 5 units are engaging in safety huddles daily. Oak unit will begin their safety huddles by mid-September. Safety huddles are an opportunity to share, raise concerns, recognize their peers, and collaborate with others to create solutions. Attendance and participation improve communication and benefit residents, families, and staff. Everyone is welcome! All staff, as well as residents and families are invited to participate. Meet Justin!




Justin Monton has joined the clinical team at Fred Douglas Lodge on August 12, 2024. His hours are Monday to Thursday.
